**CORRIGENDUM/EXTENSION OF CLOSING DATE FOR
SUBMISSION OF TENDER & OPENING DATE OF
TECHNICAL BID FOR RUNNING AND MANAGING
GROUP HOMES FOR MENTALLY ILL PERSONS**

In reference to Department of Social Welfare, Women and Child Development, Chandigarh Tender Reference No-DSW/Disability/2020/11 (Tender ID No-2020_CHD_57334_1), uploaded on 19.11.2020 and published on 20.11.2020, it is notified that the last date for submission of tender for running and managing Group Homes for 30 mentally ill persons under the provisions of the Mental Healthcare Act, 2017 is extended upto 29.12.2020 (1:00 PM). The date of opening of technical bid is on 29.12.2020 at 03:30 PM.

Points raised by Parivartan (an NGO) for clarification for pre-bid meeting fixed on 01.12.2020 at 3.00 pm

S. No.	Points raised	Clarification from the department
1.	Can the NGO be allowed to apply for register under MHCA after handing over of the building.	As mentioned in Clause No. 5(sub clause I & II) - Eligibility and pre qualification criteria of Expression of Interest, it has been mentioned that : i. Interested Bidding agency must be under the Societies Registration Act/any other relevant Act and Mental Healthcare Act, 2017. ii. Interested bidding agency must be registered on the Darpan Portal of Govt. of India i.e. ngodarpan.gov.in.
2.	Can NGO be permitted to visit the site to see the feasibility of housing 30 residents before applying for the bid? Can the number 30 be reduced depending on the status of building.	Yes, NGO is permitted to visit the site to see the feasibility of housing 30 residents before applying for the bid. The bid has been floated for running and managing Group Home for 30 mentally ill persons.
3.	Will the building be counted as given to the NGO even if the current occupants (physical disabled) continue to stay in the building.	For Running and managing group home the building will be allowed to use for designated purposes by NGO only. In no case the building will be transferred to NGO.
4.	Is the facility to be run as a paid or unpaid facility.	Will be decided at the level of competent authority. However, it will not have any financial impact on the bidding agency because charges if any, levied will go to the Social Welfare Department in accordance with the bid accepted.
5.	Can NGO still apply for the bid if GST number applied for, annual turnover not more than 5 lakh.	As per clause No. 8(sub clause m of Expression of Interest Documents)- Preparation of Technical Bid :- it is essential to have self attested copy of PAN and GST No. at the time of preparation of Technical Bid. As per clause no 5 (Eligibility and Pre-Qualification criteria sub clause VI the selected Agency's turnover (billing amount) should not be less than Rs. 5.00 Lakhs.
6.	Can the Chandigarh Administration/Department of Social Welfare provide any funding under any of the project for Group Home	The selected bidder shall be given the charges for their service on account of providing necessities of life to the resident of Group Home as per the terms and condition of Expression of Interest Documents (Refer clause No.9)
7.	Will the Chandigarh administration make changes in the premises if required.	The building has been recently renovated and in case any further renovation is required as per MHCA Act, the same will be carried out by this Department after assessing the need for the same.
