The Community Based Inclusive Development (CBID) programme aims to create a pool of grassroot rehabilitation workers at the community level, who can work alongside the ASHA and anganwadi workers to handle cross-disability issues and facilitate the inclusion of the persons with disabilities in the society.

The eligibility to enroll as a trainee in the course of Community Based Inclusive Development (CBID), Program is open to any candidate who has successfully passed the SSC 10th Standard Exam from any recognized State or Central Board and has attained the age of 18 years.
